competition rules

1. The N3 Toll Route is a section of 415,5km from Heidelberg in Gauteng to Cedara in Pietermaritzburg.
2. The primary aims of the competition are to promote the vicinity of the Route and to encourage photography as a hobby, especially among local communities and scholars.
3. Photographs should be taken in the near vicinity of the N3 Toll Route and should preferably be supplied in digital format with a minimum resolution of 300dpi.
4. If original photographs are entered, they must be unframed (maximum size: 30cm x 27cm and minimum size: 20cm x 15cm).
5. CDs and original photographs submitted as competition entries will not be returned.
6. Photographs may be in colour; sepia or black and white.
7. All entries must be accompanied by the official competition entry form, one entry form per photograph, which can be downloaded from the N3TC website www.n3tc.co.za.

9. The competition closes on 30 September 2010 and entries received after this date will not be accepted.
10. Photographers can enter a maximum of two photographs per category:
 - a. Travel and Tourism
 - b. Sport, Culture and Recreation
 - c. People
 - d. Wildlife, Fauna and Flora
 - e. Landscape
11. The following prizes will be presented:
 - a. Overall Winner : R2 000,00;
 - b. Category Winner : R1 000,00;
 - c. Category Runner-Up : R500,00;
 - d. Scholar Winner per Category : R1 000,00; and
 - e. Scholar Runner-Up per Category : R500,00
 - f. Certificates of Merit for photographs worthy of mention.
12. To qualify for the Scholar prizes, the entrant must attend a school and provide the necessary information as indicated in the entry form. The photograph must have been taken by the scholar personally.
13. The competition will be judged by a panel of independent judges.
14. Winners will be notified in writing and their prize money will be transferred into their bank accounts via EFT.
15. Winners and runners-up may be requested to be photographed for publicity purposes.
16. Winners and runners-up will be requested to sign a release allowing N3TC to use the photographs for PR purposes.
17. The Competition is open to N3 Toll Concession (Pty) Ltd employees; employees of its appointed advertising agency; members of the PIX editorial team; and members of their immediate families. However, no prize money will be awarded if the entry is selected as a category winner or runner-up.
18. A selection of the winning photographs will be published in the N3TC 2011 Corporate Calendar; N3TC's publication Mobility - and on the N3TC website in low resolution format. These photographs will also be published at N3TC's discretion, with the approval of the photographer.
19. The N3TC calendar is produced on the basis of a page a month (12) and the photographers are acknowledged.
20. Samples of the 2008, 2009 and 2010 calendars are available for review at the N3TC offices in Bedfordview.
