A. INVITATION TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO PRE-QUALIFY

1. N3TC invites applications from *Eligible* Companies “Entities”, Joint Ventures or Consortia to submit Pre-Qualification Applications to tender for various Packages of Routine Road Maintenance Contracts namely;

N3 TOLL ROUTE: CEDARA INTERCHANGE TO HEIDELBERG SOUTH INTERCHANGE
ROUTINE ROAD MAINTENANCE – PACKAGE 1, 4, 6, 7, 8, 9 & 10**

2. Definitions

- a. *Anti-Corruption Laws*: Any anti-corruption, bribery or anti-money laundering laws or regulations of the Republic of South Africa, as amended from time to time, including –
- i. the Prevention of Organised Crime Act, No 121 of 1998;
 - ii. the Protection of Constitutional Democracy against Terrorist and Related Activities Act, 33 of 2004
 - iii. the Prevention and Combating of Corrupt Activities Act, No 12 of 2004;
 - iv. the Financial Intelligence Centre Act 58 of 2001 (as amended); and
 - v. any other law of similar purpose and scope in the Republic of South Africa.
- b. *Black People*: Individuals who are citizens of the Republic of South Africa, who according to racial classification did not have the right to vote or had restricted voting rights immediately prior to the 1994 elections in South Africa.
- c. *Location*: The shortest travel distance by road from the *Domicilium citandi et executandi* of the Applicant (Head office address) **to any point for a specific Contract Package on the N3 between Cedara Interchange and Heidelberg South Interchange which shall be less than 35km**. In the case of Joint Ventures and Consortia, this criteria for eligibility applies to all members of the Joint Venture or Consortium for each specific Contract Package.
3. Only pre-qualified applicants will be invited to tender for the various RRM Contract Packages.
4. The pre-qualification document is only available on the N3TC website in .pdf format, and it is the responsibility of the Applicant to download the complete document. The document will be available on the website from **9th June 2026**.

5. The *Eligibility* criteria are as follows:

- a. The Applicant shall be either an “Entity”/company, “Joint Venture” (i.e. partnership between two entities) or a “Consortium” (i.e. group of entities). Entities or companies (including all those entities or companies forming part of a joint venture or consortia) shall have been registered and operationally active at the *Location* for at least one year prior to 9th June 2026
- b. All members of the entity or company (including all those entities and companies forming part of a joint venture or consortium) shall have their places of business for a specific Contract Package, located not more than 35km from the N3 Toll Route, and defined as Location above.
- c. Companies/Entities shall have black (Black People) shareholding of 50.1% or more.
- d. Applicants shall be registered with the CIDB for a CE designation and have a CIDB grading of between 4CE and 6CE (inclusive of 4CE and 6 CE) prior to the pre-qualification application closing.
- e. Applicants shall have previous experience of Routine Road Maintenance Contracts, with minimum of 3 completed RRM contracts (or equivalent) on National Roads in the last 5 years.
- f. Applicants shall have adequate financial resources.

- g. Applicants shall abide by all Anti-Corruption Laws and maintain adequate internal procedures to prevent the violation of any Anti-Corruption laws by the applicant and any person, affiliate and/or entity associated with the applicant in the conduct of its business, or the implementation of any contract concluded, irrespective of the capacity in which such person/entity is associated with the applicant.
- h. Applicants shall ensure that all subcontractors, agents, intermediaries and other associated persons engaged in connection with any contract awarded pursuant to this pre-qualification process are bound by equivalent anti-corruption obligations and undertakings as those set out in this document.
- i. Applicants shall be in good standing with the South African Revenue Services.
- j. Applicants shall be in good standing with the Department of Labour for Compensation for Occupational Injuries and Diseases Act.
- k. Applicants shall submit ALL the Returnable Schedules which forms part of this RFQ.
- l. Any breach of the anti-corruption undertakings set out herein or in Form B3 shall entitle N3TC, in its sole discretion, to: (a) immediately disqualify the applicant from the pre-qualification process; (b) terminate any contract awarded to the applicant; (c) recover from the applicant all losses suffered as a result of the breach; (d) debar the applicant from future N3TC procurement processes for a period determined by N3TC; and (e) report the applicant to the relevant authorities including the National Prosecuting Authority and the Register of Tender Defaulters established under section 28 of PRECCA.

6. Submission of Pre-Qualification Applications.

B. NOTES TO APPLICANTS

1. Please answer all questions and provide relevant supporting documentation electronically.
2. Please sign electronically, all pages where required.
3. Supplementary pages may be scanned and inserted if required.
4. Please retain a copy of your complete submission.
5. If a joint venture or consortium is proposed, all participating entities are to respond to all questions and provide all required information and documentation.
6. Scanned **certified copies** of **valid** SARS Tax Compliance Status declaration/PIN (1), SARS VAT registration (2), CIPC registration & **disclosure certificate** (3), proof of business/company address (4), workman's compensation (5), proof of CIDB registration with designation between 4CE and 6CE CIDB grading (6), proof of previous RRM experience (7), B-BBEE Verification Certificate (8) Intended Joint Venture Agreement (9) and duly completed declaration forms/documents **shall** accompany the applicant's Pre-qualification Application.
7. Failure to comply with 6 above may result in the Pre-qualification Application not being considered by N3TC.
8. Nothing contained in this document shall constitute a contract between an applicant and N3TC.
9. Telephonic, telegraphic, telex, facsimile or physical hardcopy Pre-qualification Applications shall not be accepted.
10. In order to be considered for Pre-qualification, applicants must comply with the minimum Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment (B-BBEE) requirements set out in item 17 below. Failure to comply with these minimum requirements shall result in a non-compliant Pre-qualification Application which shall then not be considered further and will not proceed to the evaluation phase.
11. **Conflict of Interest.** Prospective Applicants, "Consortium Members" (if the Prospective Applicant is a Consortium) including, in each case their "Affiliates", shall not have any "Conflict of Interest". The assessment of the existence of a Conflict of Interest shall be based on the specific facts of each case and more details will be required in this regard during the Pre-qualification process.
12. **Costs for Pre-Qualification.** Prospective Applicants shall bear all costs associated with their participation in the Pre-Qualification Process, including the preparation and submission of their pre-qualification proposal and all professional fees to advisors or consultants used to assist in preparation of the Pre-Qualification application. N3TC shall not be held responsible or liable in any way for such costs regardless of the Pre-Qualification Process and/or outcome.
13. **Application for Packages.** The Applicant may indicate an Application for more than one Package provided they comply with the Eligibility criteria, in particular Location. No Applicant shall be an Affiliate or a member of another Prospective Applicant. Applicants who violate this condition will automatically be disqualified.
14. **Language.** The Pre-Qualification documents and all correspondence shall be prepared in English. Any printed material or document furnished by a Prospective Applicant and written in another language shall be accompanied by an English translated version.

As an initial procurement step to the intended awarding of the contract referred to above, N3TC shall Pre-qualify applicants who have submitted acceptable and compliant Pre-qualification Applications. These Pre-qualified applicants may subsequently and in accordance with N3TC's requirements, be invited to submit a Tender to N3TC.

16. Pre-Qualifying Closing:

The completed application shall be submitted via email to rrm2026.prequal02@n3tc.co.za and received by N3TC not later than 12:00 on Tuesday 23 June 2026. Late submissions will not be accepted. Maximum file size is 20MB for the email submission.

17. Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment (B-BBEE);

For pre-qualification purposes, the applicant must be a Black Enterprise (≥ 50.1 % black ownership & substantial management control) as defined below. A valid SANAS B-BBEE certificate (or EME affidavit) is required to verify ownership; B-BBEE Level will be used only for preference points at tender stage.

The following definitions are relevant to the B-BBEE Minimum Requirements:

Black Enterprise

A black enterprise (BE) is defined as a company or economic activity that is at least 50.1% owned by black persons and where there is substantial management control by Black People. Ownership refers to economic interest, whilst management refers to the membership of any board or similar governing body of the enterprise.

Black People

Black people (BP) are defined as Africans, Coloureds and Indians who hold South African Citizenship through their right of birth, and who according to racial classification did not have the right to vote or had restricted voting rights immediately prior to the 1994 elections in South Africa.

Preference for Targeted Enterprise

A Preference Points system for BBBEE level and Locations shall apply to applications received from invited Entities, Joint Ventures or Consortia. This will be defined in the Tender Document.

This does not apply to eligibility for this Pre-qualification.

18. N3 Toll Route: Routine Road Maintenance Contract

The Pre-qualified applicants will be invited to tender (at a date to be determined by N3TC and pursuant to a request for proposal issued by N3TC) for one or more of the N3 Toll Route, Routine Road Maintenance Contract Packages.

The N3 Toll Route has been divided into ten (10) road maintenance sections, of which seven (7) are applicable to this pre-qualification. For each road maintenance section there will be a Contract Package labelled 1, 4, 6, 7, 8, 9 and 10 as applicable to that section. The extent of the Site is depicted in the attached N3 Route Card (refer to Section E). The total length of the N3TC Contract Packages applicable to this pre-qualification is ±313 km.

19. Project Description

This project comprises routine road maintenance work on the N3 Toll Route between Cedara Interchange in KwaZulu-Natal and Heidelberg South Interchange in Gauteng contained in seven (7) Contract Packages. Following the Tender process, Contract Packages for a duration of approximately 15 months will be awarded.

This project comprises of the following but not limited to:

- Repairs to damaged road furniture (including road signs, fencing and guardrails),
- Routine pavement repairs,
- Road stud installation,
- Cleaning of the road reserve and drainage structures,
- Litter collection,
- Erosion protection,
- Drainage maintenance,
- Minor repairs to structures,
- Temporary traffic accommodation,
- Environmental management,
- Health and Safety Management.

C. PRE-QUALIFICATION RULES

1. Cost Incurred for Pre-qualification

N3TC shall not be responsible for, or pay for, any expenses, costs or losses, which may be incurred by the applicant in the preparation and submission of the Pre-qualification Application.

2. Communication with applicants

All communication shall be via the designated email at rrm2026.prequal02@n3tc.co.za

3. Pre-qualification Evaluation and Acceptance

This document in its entirety, completed in every respect, together with other required supporting documentation must be submitted.

The evaluation of the applications shall be based on the presentation, completeness and compliance of the applicant's Pre-qualification Application.

The decision made by N3TC regarding the acceptance of applicants who will pre-qualify and who will be invited to respond to the Tender issued shall be final. N3TC does not bind itself to accept any of the Pre-qualification Applications. N3TC may at any time terminate the Pre-qualification process without Pre-qualifying any applicants.

4. Information and data to be completed in all respects

Provided that the omission is not a material omission, the Employer reserves the right to condone the omission and may waive any nonconformities in the application.

Provided that the omission is not a material omission, the Employer reserves the right to condone the omission and may request the applicant to submit the necessary information or documentation, within a reasonable period of time, to rectify nonmaterial nonconformities in the application related to documentation requirements.

5. Disqualification of Pre-qualification Application

The Pre-qualification Application of any applicant who has not complied with the requirements of this document and the instructions reflected therein and/or who has approached an officer or employee of N3TC before or after the Pre-qualification process, to influence the award in their favour will be disqualified at the sole discretion of N3TC.

D RETURNABLE SCHEDULES

1. Returnable schedules have been numbered and must be completed in every respect and shall include supporting documents where applicable.
2. Failure to fully complete the relevant returnable documents may render such a submission non-responsive.
3. Applicants shall note that their signatures appended to each returnable form represent a declaration that they assure the accuracy and correctness of the information provided.
4. Notwithstanding any check or audit conducted by or on behalf of N3TC, the information provided in the returnable documents is accepted in good faith and as justification for pre-qualifying the applicant. If subsequently any information is found to be incorrect and/or misleading such a discovery shall be taken as wilful misrepresentation by that applicant. In such an event N3TC has the discretionary right to disqualify the application.
5. These forms must be completed electronically in the .pdf format and any alterations made prior to the date of closure for pre-qualification, countersigned by an authorized signatory. A printed and scanned copy will be acceptable provided that each form is completed legibly and completely and supporting documents are certified and included with the scanned copy and the resolution of the scanned copy is such that the entire document is legible.
